The Council also discussed the potential benefits of using Flock cameras to monitor traffic in transit through New Westover that occurs on Westover Drive. Mayor Thompson asked Chief Martinez to investigate two (2) additional Flock cameras for Westover Drive.

Mayor Thompson made observations of potential errors and inconsistencies in the Activities Report. Chief of Police Martinez agreed and indicated the report data will be reviewed and corrected for the next council meeting.
