Dear Westover Hills Resident,

The Town of Westover Hills has adopted the directive issued by Governor Abbott related to COVID-19 to restrict visitation to public facilities and accordingly, effective today, has closed general public access to Town Hall for non-emergency activity. The Town will reopen general public access to Town Hall when appropriate.

The Town will continue perform normal police patrol and garbage pickup although Town employees have been directed to maintain adequate distance from all individuals during non-emergency activity.

The police will continue to be available to collect mail, packages and newspapers when requested by residents when out of town and the contents will be delivered to residences upon notification of return.

Town management has adopted measures to limit meetings and will adopt teleconferencing technology to facilitate administrative meetings and future town council meetings.
