### **Community Interactions**

There were 496 community interactions from October 5, 2020 through October 11, 2020. Of these calls, there were 9 burglar alarms, 1 fire response and 1 medical response. Officers initiated 0 traffic stops, no pedestrian stops, and handled 2 possible Town Ordinance complaints. Officers initiated 93 housewalk checks and 69 construction sites for noise violations and theft prevention.

### **Of Note**

10/05 An evening officer responded to a suspicious person at the intersection of Merrymount Rd. and Canterbury Dr. The officer made contact with the person matching the description. An older b/f was walking through town in an attempt to get home but was lost. The officer transported the woman back to her home without incident.

10/06 During a housewalk check the officer found a garage door to be open with the remaining doors secured. Contact with the resident was made. No signs of criminal activity or theft. Garage door secured. No further incident.

10/06 An officer responded to a noise complaint at the 70 block of Westover Terrace. The officer spoke with the construction crew about their noise. The crew was apologetic and said that they would keep it down.

10/06 Found property was brought to the police department. An attempt to contact the owner was made however unsuccessful. The property was processed. No further information.

10/07 An officer assisted a resident at the 6000 block of Merrymount Rd. with confirming the identity of a contractor that was asking for access to the property. The officer confirmed the contractor. No incident.

10/10 Officers responded to a report of solicitors at the 1400 block of Westover Ln. Officers made contact with both solicitors. Citations were issued and the solicitors left town without incident.
