Community Interactions

There were 271 community interactions from September 28, 2020 through October 4, 2020. Of these calls, there were 8 burglar alarms, 1 fire response and 1 medical response. Officers initiated 1 traffic stop, no pedestrian stops, and handled 6 possible Town Ordinance complaints. Officers initiated 79 housewalk checks and 54 construction sites for noise violations and theft prevention.
