Community Interactions

There were 415 community interactions from October 26, 2020 through November 1, 2020. Of these calls, there were 14 burglar alarms, 2 fire response and no medical responses. Officers initiated 0 traffic stops, no pedestrian stops, and handled 3 possible Town Ordinance complaints. Officers initiated 46 housewalk checks, 172 house observations, and 61 construction sites for noise violations and theft prevention.

10/28 Officers responded to possible mail fraud at the 50 block of Valley Ridge. Officers investigated and collected evidence. Investigation to continue in cooperation with USPS.
