### ***Community Interactions***

There were 810 community interactions from November 23, 2020 through November 29, 2020. Of these calls, there were 14 burglar alarms, 2 fire responses and 3 medical responses. Officers initiated 4 traffic stops, no pedestrian stops, and handled 4 possible Town Ordinance complaints. Officers initiated 40 housewalk checks, 535 house observations and 74 construction site checks for noise violations and theft prevention.

### ***Of Note***

11/28 An evening officer responded to found property at the 2100 block of Hidden Creek Rd. A security officer had witnessed a suspicious vehicle discard items from their car and leave. WHPD officer retrieved and processed items which were pieces of mail belonging to W.H. residents. Suspect and vehicle were recorded on camera. This is an ongoing investigation.

11/24 An evening officer responded to a medical call at the 40 block of Valley Ridge Rd. The patient had fallen and was unable to get up. The officer made a medical assessment and provided assistance. The patient refused Medstar services. No further information.

11/23 Officers responded to a medical call at the 2100 block of Hidden Creek Rd. The officers made an assessment of the patient and gave assistance. Medstar took over care and transported the patient to a local hospital. No further information.
