Community Interactions

There were 324 community interactions from October 25, 2021, through October 31, 2021. Of these calls, there were 9 burglar alarms, 1 fire response and no medical responses. Officers initiated 6 traffic stops, no pedestrian stops, and handled 6 possible town ordinance complaints. Officers initiated 17 house walk checks, 123 house observations and 19 construction sites for noise violations and theft prevention.

Of Note

10/25 An evening officer made a traffic stop at 900 Roaring Springs Road after the vehicle ran the red light at the Roaring Springs Rd. and Merrymount Rd. intersection. The driver was confirmed to have a warrant from Tarrant County for possession of marijuana. The driver was arrested and transported to TCSO at 100 N.
